Edward Bear meets on the first Friday of the month during term-time, 2 – 3pm, usually at St Barnabas Church, Great Tey unless otherwise specified.

Edward Bear is for Babies, Toddlers, Under 5's and their parents or carers. Edward Bear starts with a bible story and singing/rhymes followed by craft, play and refreshments.

(before Edward Bear a message is sent to each family inviting them to Edward Bear) This message will include wearing a face mask/shield, sanitizing of hands and keeping a safe distance from other adults. Sanitize hands on entry to the Church Sanitize hands on leaving/exit of Church Edward Bear to keep a register of everyone who attends, including contact details. Leader of the group to sign Edward

Use of the toilet	All group members	Spread of COVID- 19	medium	 Bear Group on the sign in sheet for the Church, this ensures that details can be given for Track and Trace purposes. Adults to wear masks whilst in the building Leader and helper to wear face shields to enable telling of stories and communicating. Parents may be asked to wait outside the church until the family in front have sanitized hands and entered the building, moving out of the foyer area. The toilet will be available for use during Edward Bear, it will have been cleaned before the group starts. Parent will accompany their child to the toilet. Sanitize hands prior to entry of toilet, wash hands for 20 seconds after use of toilet and sanitize hands on exit. Paper towels will be provided for drying of hands Sanitizing spray is available in the 'bathroom' to wipe over after use. Group leader to notify 'church warden – Chris P' if the toilets have been used during Edward Bear.

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				 Children or other adults will not be allowed to access toy store to choose their own toys. Toys used will be 'quarantine' after each Edward Bear. Although no other group uses these toys. Soft toys or toys hard to clean will not be used at this present time Toys will be regularly cleaned/sanitized by Elizabeth (wipes will be provided for parents to wipe toys over between children playing with them)
Craft/food activities	Children and their parent/carer	Spread of Covid-19 through sharing of resources	Medium	 Each child will have individual pots of utensils, there will be no communal plates/pots for sharing. Parents will be reminded to keep their distance from other adults and encouraged to only help their child.
Story-time and time of 'worship/singing'	All group participants	Spread of Covid-19	Medium	 Wearing of face masks or visors by adults. Chairs will be set out so that adults are SD at the front of church where the weather is suitable Edward Bear will meet outside. Families will be asked to bring their own picnic blanket to sit on for the story time. Children will continue to be able to sit on

				 the floor together to listen to the story. Instead of a time of singing we will have music playing and share some spoken finger rhymes.
Refreshments – this is integral part of baby and toddler groups. Often a time when parents are able to have a hot drink.	All group participants	Spread of Covid-19 by sharing of utensils,	Medium	 The utensils will be used only by Edward Bear group. Utensils will be cleaned afterwards in Elizabeth's dishwasher A hot water dispenser will be prepared in advance and placed on the refreshment table. Refreshments will be made only by Emma (who will sanitize her hands before this 'task') One spoon per 'drink' no shared spoons Individual packets of biscuits will be offered Dirty mugs/spoons/beakers will be placed directly back into 'a washing up bowl' by the parent. Likewise, children will have a drink made for them by Emma and individual packets of biscuits for their snack.
